- Rules the world

- Sows unbelievers among believers
- Performs miracles

## After Satan's Fall: PRESENT Works

- Advances immorality
- Targets God's people:
  - **hindering**
  - **through temptation**
  - uses our **fleshly/carnal** behavior
  - brings **physical** problems
- Influences government
- Lies and deceives

## After Satan's Fall: FUTURE Works

## Zechariah 12:3 (ESV)

"On that day I will make Jerusalem a heavy stone for all the peoples. All who lift it will surely hurt themselves. And all the nations of the earth will gather against it."

## Zechariah 14:2–3 (ESV)

"For I will gather all the nations against Jerusalem to battle, and the city shall be taken and the houses plundered and the women raped. Half of the city shall go out into exile, but the rest of the people shall not be cut off from the city.

(3) Then the LORD will go out and fight against those nations as when he fights on a day of battle."

“Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, holding in his hand the key to the bottomless pit and a great chain. (2)And he seized the dragon, that ancient serpent, who is the devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years, (3)and threw him into the pit, and shut it and sealed it over him, so that he might not deceive the nations any longer, until the thousand years were ended. After that he must be released for a little while.”

## 1 Peter 5:8–9 (ESV)

"Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. **(9)** Resist him, firm in your faith, knowing that the same kinds of suffering are being experienced by your brotherhood throughout the world."

## Revelation 20:7–9 (ESV)

"And when the thousand years are ended, Satan will be released from his prison (8) and will come out to deceive the nations that are at the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them for battle; their number is like the sand of the sea. (9) And they marched up over the broad plain of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city, but fire came down from heaven and consumed them"

## Matthew 25:31–34 (ESV)

"When the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, then He will sit on His glorious throne. (32) Before Him will be gathered all the nations, and He will separate people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats.

(33) And He will place the sheep on His right, but the goats on the left. (34) Then the King will say to those on His right, 'Come, you who are blessed by My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world.

## Matthew 25:35-38 (ESV)

“For I was hungry and you gave Me food, I was thirsty and you gave Me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed Me, (36) I was naked and you clothed Me, I was sick and you visited Me, I was in prison and you came to Me.’ (37) Then the righteous will answer Him, saying, ‘Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed You, or thirsty and give You drink? (38) And when did we see You a stranger and welcome You, or naked and clothe You?’

## Matthew 25:39-42 (ESV)

And when did we see You sick or in prison and visit You?’  
(40)And the King will answer them, ‘Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these My brothers, you did it to Me.’ (41)Then He will say to those on his left, ‘Depart from Me, you cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels. (42)For I was hungry and you gave Me no food, I was thirsty and you gave Me no drink,

## Matthew 25:43-46 (ESV)

I was a stranger and you did not welcome Me, naked and you did not clothe Me, sick and in prison and you did not visit Me.'

(44)Then they also will answer, saying, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not minister to You?' (45)Then He will answer them, saying, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to Me.' (46)And these will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life.'"

## Revelation 20:10 (NAS95)

“And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are also; and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.”
